

Learning outcomes for Spanish kids' classes - April, 2017 term

Group – From 3 to 7 years old:

- 1. Introducing yourself Greetings in Spanish
- 2. Saying your name: Use of yo soy, tú eres, él es/ella es (I am, you are, he/she is)
- 3. Alphabet and sounds in Spanish
- 4. Numbers and telling your age
- 5. Days of the week and months of the year: When is your birthday and holidays
- 6. Seasons of the year: Review of birthday and holidays
- 7. Food, fruits and colours
- 8. Talking about likes and dislikes with favourite activities/hobbies
- There is a proposal of further objectives below depending on the class progress and needs:
- a) Animals and pets
- b) Easy verbs for actions
- c) Talking about how you feel ¡Estoy feliz!

Group - From 8 to 12 years old:

- 1. Talking about yourself: Your name, your age, nationality, where you live and your favourite hobbies
- 2. Talking about your family: Introducing parents, grandparents, brothers and sisters
- 3. Talking about jobs: Learn about jobs and what you would like to do when you grow up. Use of the tense "me gustaría ser"
- 4. Personal appearance: What you look like and describing other people. Using yo, tú, él/ella es
- 5. The verb to be ser/estar: Creating simple sentences
- 6. My school: Talking about places, your day, time and your friends. Introducing the use of the verb hacer
- 7. Food talking about eating, cooking, shopping for food. Using the verbs querer/preferir
- 8. Holidays places you would like to go and what you like to do
- Please note that for the classes from 8 to 12 the new topics will be combined with topics learned in the past and previous lessons.
- The topics may change slightly depending on the class progress and needs.
- Each topic will be practiced through the use of games, songs and/or short videos.
