- CELTA is the most widely recognised qualification for teaching English as foreign language (TEFL) in the world.
- CELTA is administered by Cambridge Assessment English.

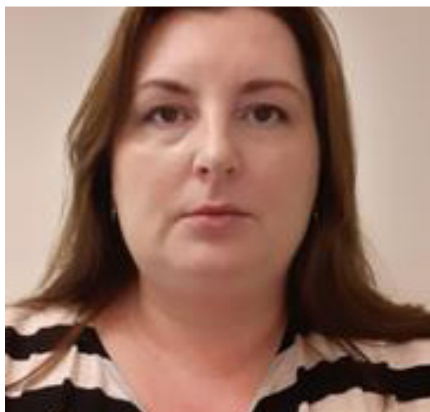

## Course price for 2023

The course fee for all CELTA courses in 2023 is £1,450.

## Modes of delivery

- 4-week intensive face-to-face CELTA courses (all teaching practice and input sessions take place at our centre in Glasgow)
- 4-week intensive online CELTA courses (all teaching practice and input sessions take over Zoom)
- 10-week online CELTA courses (teaching practice takes place two evenings per week every week of the course and input is completed by working through online Moodle units at a time which suits you)

## Is there funding available?

If eligible, you can get £200 ITA funding towards all of our CELTA courses. You must be:

- Aged 16 or over
- Not in education or involved in any other SDS funded programme
- Unemployed and looking to get back into work OR employed, earning less than £22,000 per year and looking to progress in or change your job
- Resident in Scotland
